REGISTRATION

All campers must have a North Penn YMCA membership: Youth Program - \$50/year.

Weekly tuition payments are due two (2) weeks prior to thesession start date. See the Payment Schedule in our Summer Camp Parent Handbook. All checks must bemade payable to the North Penn YMCA.

Due to size limitations at our camp locations, all registrations are on a first come, first serve basis. Registration requires a non-refundable deposit of \$25per week to secure your child's spot in our camp. Please note, all camp locations must have at least 20 campers minimum enrolled for that location to open for the 2022 season.

Completed summer camp registration packets can be dropped off at either the Indian Valley or Harleysville Early Childhood Center. Please refer to our registrationpacket for a complete list of forms that need to be submitted at the time of registration.

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REGISTRATION DEPOSITS

- \$25 deposit per week per child due upon registration
- Deposit is deducted from final weekly payments due 2 weeks before the start of that weekly sessions.

WHAT TO BRING

1. Sack Lunch and Water Bottle

No refrigeration or microwave available. One snack is provided daily or parent may pro-vide. Camp is Nut Free.

2. Proper Clothing

Campers will be active and may get dirty. Please dress your camper appropriately.

- 4. Closed-toe Shoes
- 5. Spray on Sunscreen



WHAT IS THE Y DOING TO PRIORITIZE HEALTH AND SAFETY FOR MY CHILD AT CAMP?

To assure the safest possible environment for your child at summer camp, the following policies and procedures have been adopted based on recommendations and guidelines from the Center for Disease Control (CDC), Pennsylvania Department of Health and the American Camping Association.

- 1. Medication— If a camper is in need of medication, it will be required that a medical log is completed by the parent on their first day of camp. All medications must be kept in their original child-resistant containers, labeled with the original prescription label.
- **2. Policy on Face Coverings** Face coverings are recommended but not required unless ordered the Montgomery County Health Department.
- **3. Social Distancing** Camp groups will include the same children each day to reduce risk of potential exposure. Social distancing will be maintained by utilizing outdoor spaces and larger indoor spaces.
- 4. **Camp Group Sizes** Group sizes will be one staff per twelve campers and campers will remain with theircounselors and away from other groups throughout the day.
- 5. **Handwashing & Sanitizing** We will ensure frequent hand washing with warm soap and water for 20 seconds periodically throughout the day depending on the camp group activities. The Y will implement sanitation procedures throughout the day, disinfectinghigh volume surfaces such as doorknobs, tables and bathrooms regularly.
- 6. **Packed Lunches Requirements** All lunches should be packed in disposable wrap and in disposable bags. We are a NUT FREE camp.
- 7. **Personal Items with Campers** Campers may only bring essential items such as spray-on sunscreen, bathing suit, towel, nut free lunch, snacks, water bottle, hats, sandals/crocs, and a change of clothes.
- 8. Pick up/drop off procedures Outside when possible and weather permitting. Each site will have unique drop off protocols that will communicated in your initial Welcome Newsletter.
