REGISTRATION

- All campers must have a North Penn YMCA membership: Youth Program - \$50/year.
- Weekly tuition payments are due two (2) days prior to the session start date. See the Payment Schedule in our Summer Camp Parent Handbook. All checks must be made payable to the North Penn YMCA.
- Registration requires a non-refundable deposit of \$25 per week to secure your child's spot in our camp. Due to size limitations at our camp locations, all registrations are on a first come, first serve basis.
- Camp registration packets are available at the Welcome Centers or can be printed from our website. Completed summer camp registration packets can be dropped off at the Lansdale Area Family YMCA. Camp registration packets can also be filled out electronically and emailed to camp@northpennymca.org.
- Please refer to our registration packet for a complete list of forms that need to be submitted at the time of registration.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
